Visual Transcript of "Search Team Two: Interior Search Division Two"

00:00- 00:19 Title Caption, Orderville Fire Department, Team Two Interior Search Division Two
[**00:00-01:16**] [ambient sounds, sounds of fire crackling lightly, crews moving through space, voice communications between crews, radio alert/key sounds]

00:19-05:01, light smoke from windows

01:25 crew waving halligan tool across floor.

01:27 crew spreads out, uses foot to maintain contact

01:27 middle firefighter taps wall firefighter on shoulder to communicate to begin search of room

01:28 two from search crew separate from control/door firefighter.

01:28 wall firefighter uses hand to sweep up wall, using touch to find landmarks

01:28-01:51 the crew fans out to spread the room, while wall firefighter uses axe to sound floor and provide aural reference point for crew to navigate/orient from.

01:28-01:51 sound of voices, oral communication.

01:51 crew calls for control firefighter at door to push up, follows wall.

01:51-02:30 search continues. thermal imaging spotty at times.

02:30 Lt Lamb calls for smoke conditions

02:34 radio transmission from team two, light smoke conditions no fire showing.

03:47 command from team two, message unclear

03:55 crew opens windows on second floor.

04:08 low air alarm sounds
